PATIENT POST-OPERATIVE CARE

1. No spitting, rinsing, drinking through a straw, or sucking on mints, candy etc., for the first 24 hours (these all cause suction in the mouth which promotes bleeding).
2. Smoking inhibits healing and can affect the final results of treatment. Please refrain from smoking as much as possible!
3. For the first 24-36 hours apply an ice bag or cold compress (20 minutes on / 20 minutes off) to the outside of your face over the operated area. This will help keep the swelling and discoloration to a minimum.
4. Eat soft foods and avoid all chewing in the operated area until you return to the office for the post-operative visit.
5. You may rinse gently with mouth rinse as prescribed starting this evening.
6. Follow instructions given for surgical area and your normal home care program in all other areas.
7. The packing (if used) may come loose prior to your post-operative visit. Remove loose pieces and continue to avoid the area. If doctor specifies, gentle brushing can be performed where the packing has come off.
